

Pre-K/K SIRI Writing and Early Literacy

Description:

Using research-based text materials as an organizing structure, the Pre-K/K SIRI modules build upon the Preschool Literacy Core by helping teachers build knowledge and skills to support learning through intentional teaching and to integrate program content delivery with the Early Learning Content Standards.

In this course, participants will learn to identify and analyze various genres and formats in young children's literature and explain how it can support the social, emotional, intellectual, language, and literacy development of young children. The differentiation between drawing and writing stages, strategies for moving children through the stages, and the importance of fine motor development will be discussed. Participants will explore early writing activities, practices, and materials that are aligned with the Ohio Early Learning Content Standards and will discuss how home and school settings can support early writing.
